As of 2000, Calais had a population of 1,522, comprised completely of rural residents. The population has only increased by 0.07% since 1990. Calais contains more females than males. Approximately 51% of the total population is female, while 49% is male. Table A. shows the breakdown of age groups amongst the total population in Calais. Approximately 28% of the population is children, age 18 and under, while 10% of the population is senior citizens, age 65 and over. The number of residents age 18 and under has decreased, while the number of residents age 65 and over has increased throughout the last decade. There are currently 10% less children and 20.5% more senior citizens in Calais than there were in 1990.

Of the total population in Calais, 100% live in households. Of these people, 85% live in family households, while 15% live in nonfamily households. Of the 586 total households in Calais, 70% are family households, while 30% are nonfamily households. Most of the family households contain 2 to 4 persons. Approximately 39% are 2-person households, while 25% are 3-person households, and 24% are 4-person households. Most of the nonfamily households contain 1 or 2 persons. Approximately 73% are 1-person households and 26% are 2-person households. Compared to 1990, there are currently 7.1% more households in Calais. See Table B. for details related to household data.

Of the 412 total families that reside in Calais, approximately 87% are married-couple families. Of these married-couple families, 52% have children under the age of 18, while 48% do not have children under the age of 18. The remaining 13% of families in Calais fall under the category of other family. See Table C. for details. Approximately 58% of these families have a female householder with no husband present, while 42% of these families have a male householder with no wife present. In total, there are 0.7% less families residing in Calais than there were in 1990.

In Calais, there are 803 workers age 16 and over, which is a 12.2% increase from 1990. Approximately 21% of these workers work in Calais, while 79% work outside of the

community. The majority of workers, 84%, travel to work by car, truck, van, or motorcycle. Approximately 87% of those who travel to work by car, truck, van, or motorcycle drive alone, while 13% use carpools. See Table D. for other means of transportation used by workers in Calais. Although there are a range of travel times for Calais workers, 16% commute between 5 and 19 minutes. Approximately 53% commute between 20 and 39 minutes. Only 3.2% travel less than 5 minutes to work, while 0.9% travel more than 90 minutes to work from Calais.

In Calais, there were 394 people attending school at some level in 2000, which is a 4.2% increase from 1990. A range of educational attainment is represented by the population in Calais. Only 0.1% of all residents 25 years and older have not completed any level of schooling, while 24% have only a high school diploma. Approximately 50% of Calais residents 25 years and older hold some type of degree, ranging from an Associates degree to a Doctorate degree. See Table E. for details.

In Calais, there are 861 residents in the labor force, which is 74% of the population age 16 and over. This is a 7% increase from 1990. Approximately 95% of the people in the civilian labor force are employed, while 5% are unemployed. Although 42 residents of Calais are unemployed, this is 4.5% less than the unemployment level in 1990. All of the industries covered in the Census are represented by residents of Calais. The industries with the largest percentage of workers are: education, health, and social services, which represents 27.3% of employed residents; public administration, which represents 10.1% of employed residents; and manufacturing, which represents 9.9% of employed residents. Table G. shows household income and family income data for Calais. All income classes are represented here. Approximately 4% of the total households have an income of less than \$10,000; 16% have an income between \$10,000 and \$25,000; 36% have an income between \$25,000 and \$50,000; 27% have an income between \$50,000 and \$75,000; 10% have an income between \$75,000 and \$100,000; and 6.5% have an income above \$100,000. In 1999, the median household income for Calais was \$46,083, which is a 34.5% increase from 1990. Approximately 4% of the total families have an income of less than \$10,000; 9% have an income between \$10,000 and \$25,000; 38% have an income between \$25,000 and \$50,000; 29% have an income between \$50,000 and \$75,000; 12.5% have an income between \$75,000 and \$100,000; and 7% have an income above \$100,000. In 1999, the median family income in Calais was \$49,107, which is a 28.2% increase from 1990. In 1999, the per capita income for Calais was \$20,722, a 47.8% increase from 1990. Approximately 6.5% of people in Calais for whom poverty status is determined have incomes below poverty level. Fortunately, the 99 residents who have an income below poverty level are 7.5% less than those who suffered from poverty in 1990.

There are 769 total housing units in Calais, all of which are located in a rural area. This is a 13.3% increase from the total housing units in 1990. Approximately 80% of these housing units are currently occupied, leaving 20% vacant. Only 2% of these vacant housing units are for rent, while 4.5% are for sale. There are currently 15.9% more

housing vacancies and 12.6% more housing occupancies in Calais than there were in 1990. See Table H. for details.

Of the 616 total occupied housing units in Calais, 57% are 1 to 2 person households, while 34% are 3 to 4 person households. Of the 769 total housing units in the Town, most have between 5 and 9 rooms. Approximately 5% have 1 to 2 rooms; 17% have 3 to 4 rooms; 40% have 5 to 6 rooms; 25% have 7 to 8 rooms; and 13% have 9 or more rooms. Many of the housing units in Calais were built prior to 1980. Approximately 39% of the houses were built before 1939; 33% were built between 1940 and 1979; and 27% were built after 1980. Approximately 95% of the total housing units in Calais contain complete plumbing facilities, leaving 5% without adequate plumbing. See Table J. for details.
